What Is the NAABT Patient/Physician Matching System?

This system is a centralized, strictly confidential way for physicians to select and contact patients as treatment openings become available in his or her practice.

This web-based system offers patients in need of Buprenorphine treatment the opportunity to anonymously register and, in effect, be on the waiting lists of all participating certified physicians in their geographic area.

Advantages to the Physician:

- Potential patients are screened through a 16-question registration form
- 24/7 access to a continuously updated list of potential patients
- Email alert option as new patients register
- Patients are required to renew their status every two weeks if not contacted
- Potential patient is notified by email to contact you for an appointment
- A larger pool of potential patients
- Reduced office time spent:
 - In maintaining your own waiting list
 - Placing phone calls to reach potential patients

Advantages to the Patient:

- Receives care more quickly
- Complete anonymity and confidentiality
- One-time registration allows patients, in essence, to be put on the lists of many physicians at once
- Registration can be done by a counselor or advocate
- At no time is any identifiable information made visible
- Patient is notified by email, thereby maintaining added confidentiality
- No daily calls to physicians checking for openings
- 24/7 access

• How to Register •



- 1 Click on the Patient/Doctor Connection • Patient/Physician Matching System button on the NAABT Home Page (www.naabt.org).
- 2 Click on the Physician button.
- 3 Under Physician Sign-in, click on the "Register" Button.

When registering you will be asked for your:


- Name • Practice address • Email address
